CONCEPT STATEMENT

THE NEW DESIGN WAS TO CREATE A MODERN BALINESE STYLE HOME THAT BROUGHT THE OUTDOORS INSIDE BY INCORPORATING A LOT OF NATURAL ELEMENTS INSIDE THE HOME. THE USE OF NATURAL HARDWOOD, STONE, WATER FEATURE WALL AND PLANTS ACHIEVED THIS. KEEPING IN MIND THE FAMILIES LIFESTYLE AND CULTURE WAS IMPORTANT. HAVING AN OPEN FLOOR PLAN ALLOWED THEM TO HAVE A HOME TO FIT THEIR LIFESTYLE BUT HAVING A CLOSED OFF WET KITCHEN ADHERED TO THEIR CULTURE. 









TELEPHONE, ELECTRICAL, AND LIGHTING PLAN
