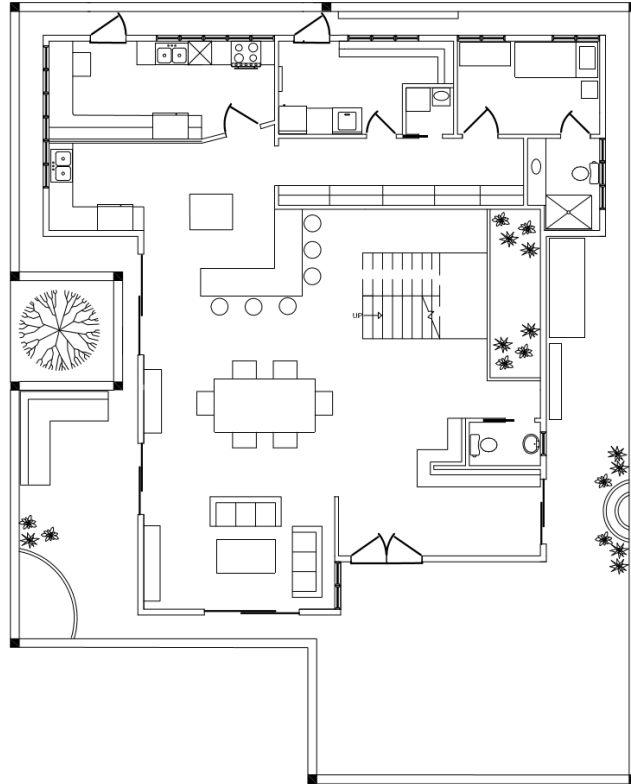
- Located: Petaling Jaya, Selangor Malaysia

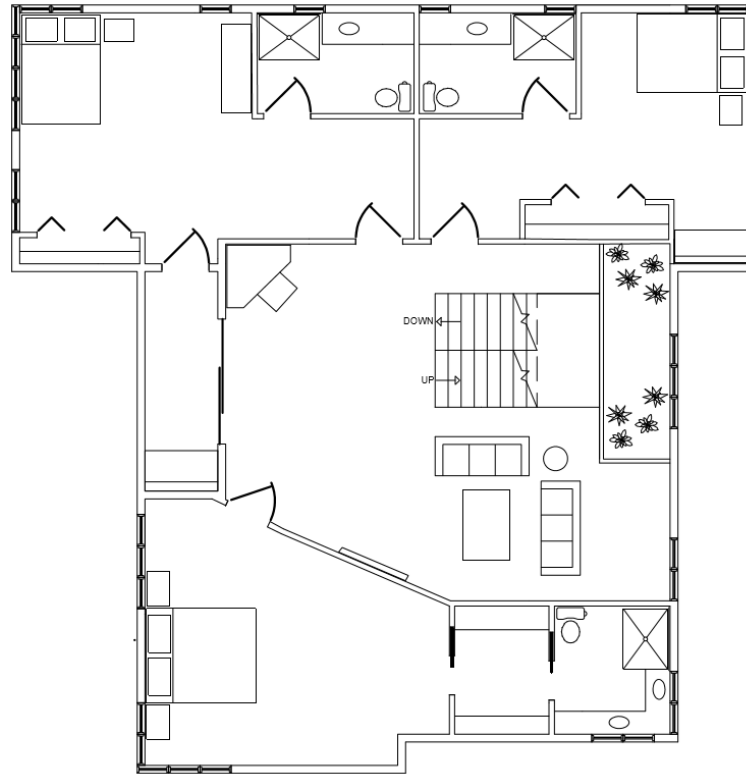
# Concept Statement

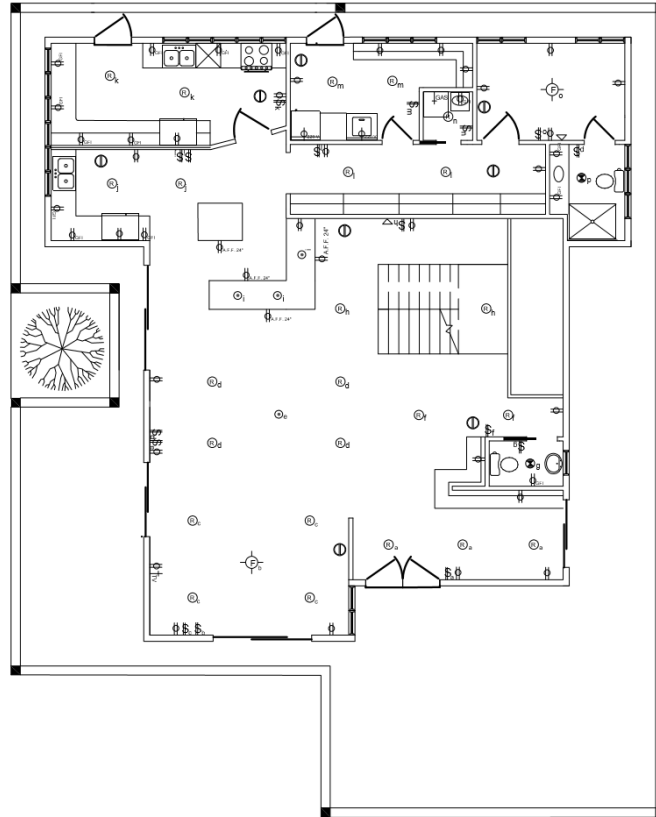


